### **24/076 –Reports from District Council, County Council and Parish**

**District Councillor Angela Clear** – Winchester City Council (WCC) Local Plan Regulation 19, the plan is now open for public consultation until 13<sup>th</sup> October.

A final decision on the Bishops Waltham Waste & Recycling centre will be made at a Hampshire County Council meeting on 14<sup>th</sup> October.

The new waste collection cycle starts 7<sup>th</sup> October and with a change in routes will reduce journeys by 35,000 miles per annum. Collections are also now greener, thanks to the vehicles being fuelled by Hydrotreated Vegetable Oil (HVO) instead of diesel

- a) **Trampers Lane Verges**– The additional cut by the Parish Lengthsman was completed
- b) **Dead wildlife and where to report** – Boarhunt is not designated as a TB area by DEFRA, any dead animals found on roads can be reported on the Winchester City Council website for removal.

  - VI. **Basketball Hoop** – the hoop has been purchased, pending installation
