MINUTES of the Full Council Meeting held at the Memorial Hall 7.30 pm on Wednesday 7th August 2024

24/045 - Apologies –Patricia Stallard, Angela Clear, Chris Chamberlain, Tiggy Ayoub, Daryll Pynigar & Eddie Schofield

24/046 – Dispensations for disclosable pecuniary interests under Section 33 of the Localism Act 2011 - The Clerk advised none for this meeting.

24/047 - Declarations of Disclosable pecuniary and non-pecuniary interests on the agenda – none.

24/048 – Public Participation and Reports from District Council, County Council and Parish Chair of Hampshire – The Parish Clerk read out a summary of Patricia’s report.

Road Repairs – April 2023 – April 2024, Hampshire completed 180,909 repairs an increase of 37% on the previous year.

Foster Carers – Hampshire have joined with 19 other councils to form the country’s largest fostering partnership. With over 11,000 children in care across the South-East and fewer than 3,000 approved carers. Anyone interested in becoming a carer please call 0300 131 2797.

Domestic Abuse – During major sporting events domestic abuse and violence increases by 1/3 when England lose or by 1/4 if England win. If you need assistance, please call 03300 165 112.

Waste – Hampshire has three Energy Recovery Facilities (ERF) where all waste is incinerated, less than 5% goes to landfill.

District Councillor Neil Cutler – A new calendar for waste collection is due to be circulated in mid-September for the Winchester district, some changes may be necessary because food waste collection will be added in 2025. Winchester have purchased a new electrical vehicle in preparation.

Councillor Cutler now holds regular meetings with the Enforcement team as our local Ward has over 40 cases, some of which have been ongoing for years.

Local Plan Regulation 19 – the Local plan is shortly due to go out for a six-week consultation period in preparation for publishing in June 2025. Winchester Districts house allocation has increased from 675 to 1099 houses each year. An emergency council meeting will take place on 28th August in preparation for the consultation period. All Winchester Council meetings are available for public attendance either in person or online.

Members of the Public asked questions about:

- Hedging at the Trampers Lane/Southwick Road T junction is impeding visibility
- Hedging on the East side of Trampers Lane also impeding visibility
 - Clerk to raise to Hampshire Highways
- Maurie Stares emailed the Clerk raising the issue of hedging along Southwick Road, adjacent Mount Folly House and opposite Rowndale
 - Councillor Trew to contact owner

- a) **Wickham Court** – The Sewer treatment plant has now been fixed and is fully operational

24/055 - Boarhunt Facilities

- a) Playground equipment inspection – July weekly checks confirmed.
- b) Allotments – a report of Plots 6 & 7 being overgrown to be investigated by the Clerk
- c) Recreation Ground – Toilet Leak, a resident has offered to fix the leak. Councillor Trew to liaise
- d) Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) funds – the Parish Council have allocated funds to the following projects
 - I. Recreation ground - Add additional gate for pushchair access
 - II. Update the Playground equipment
 - III. Add a Basketball hoop
 - IV. Replace and relocate the village noticeboards

24/056 - Boarhunt Community

- a) **Summer Dance** – 91 people attended the barn dance and a good time was had by all, the Caller and the bucking bronco were very successful. We raised £450 for Cancer Research.
- b) **Speedwatch** – Boarhunt continue to be a very active speedwatch team
 - a. May – 115 first time speeders, 4 regular offenders and 1 rejected number plate
 - b. June – 118 first time speeders, 5 regular offenders and 10 rejected number plate
 - c. Wickham and Shedfield Parish Councils to start a speedwatch scheme

- c) **Community Litter pick day** – the Parish Council would like to organise a litter pick day for 21st September to cover Trampers Lane and the Recreation Ground
- d) **Harvest Festival** – to be held on the same day as the litter pick with various categories
- e) **Scarecrow Competition** – a discussion was held to see if this event could be viable during the half term week in October.
- f) **Parish Magazine** – work on increasing the content and changing the format of the parish magazine continues. Volunteers to write regular articles are being arranged.
- g) **Community Bus** – the Clerk is looking into the various option for organising a bus to visit Boarhunt and Southwick. The idea would be to connect to Wickham & Cosham. A meeting was held at Wickham Court where 30+ residents attended. Further meetings to be held in North Boarhunt and Southwick.
- h) **South Coast Dubs Festival** – one resident has made a complaint about the event to Winchester City Council
