**25/096** – Dispensations for disclosable pecuniary interests under Section 33 of the Localism Act 2011 – None declared

**25/097** - Declarations of Disclosable pecuniary and non-pecuniary interests on the agenda – None declared

### **25/098 –Reports from District Council, County Council and Parish**

**District Councillor Neil Cutler** – Local Government Organisation (LGR) 12 Councils are working together on a joint proposal. It is proposed there will be 4 Unitary Authorities (UA) there are 3 different options how these UAs will be created. The Winchester City Council (WCC) will meet in late September to approve one option. Hampshire County Council (HCC) have decided on an alternative proposal with 3 UA.

Food waste collections – Information and timetables have been sent to all residents, caddies & bags will be distributed from 12<sup>th</sup> January 2026 with a phased release. Boarhunt collections will start from 2<sup>nd</sup> February

**Resident** – The gutters along Trampers Lane need clearing before winter to reduce localised flooding. Recreation ground track hedge needs cutting – Clerk to arrange both

### **25/100 – Planning Applications**

- a) None received this month

### **25/101 – Permitted Development**

- a) **25/00942/FUL** – The Yard, Trampers Lane. Condition 4 variation - approved
- b) **24/00341/FUL** – Land adjacent to Springfield, Trampers Lane. Adjust boundary – rejected

### **25/102 – Boarhunt Environment**

- a) **Trampers Lane Verges**– Due to the overgrowth density not all of Trampers Lane could be completed. Request an additional visit.
- b) **Southwick Road pathways** – Clerk to contact Wickham Parish Council to apply joint pressure to HCC.

### **25/103 - Boarhunt Facilities**

- a) **Playground equipment inspection** – August weekly checks confirmed
- b) **Allotment Inspection** – Councillor Trew plus one other Councillor to organise before the next Parish Council meeting
- c) **Pavilion quotes** – 4 requests for quotes (RFQ) sent out, one response received so far
- d) **Recreation Ground**
  - I. Four Councillors cleared the overgrowth from the skate park
  - II. Quotation for skate park rails requested
  - III. Councillor Schofield to put up skate park information sign
  - IV. Councillor Schofield to repair skate park concrete infill
- e) **Noticeboards** – All three noticeboards installed. Boarhunt Parish Council name to be added to the two new noticeboards

### **25/104 - Boarhunt Community**

- a) **Christmas event** – Organisation is well under way
  - a. Request for Parish Council to fund £1000 approved by all Councillors present
  - b. Two potential sponsors have come forward, more sponsorships are available
- b) **Scarecrow Competition** – Three independent judges have been chosen, Parish Council to start advertising the event
- c) **Bonfire Night** – Planning is underway for 1<sup>st</sup> November, full risk assessment to be completed
- d) **Speedwatch** – Started in October 2022:
  - a. 5002 vehicles caught speeding through the village (average speed 39.7mph)
    - i. 3501 vehicles caught using the speed gun (average speed 39.4mph)
    - ii. 1501 vehicles caught using speed camera (average speed 40.3mph)

### **25/105 – Parish Council**

- a) Councillors to prepare Precept planning 2026/27 – meeting agreed for later in September
- b) Lease for allotment up for renewal – all councillors approved
- c) Lease for recreation ground up for renewal – all councillors approved

### **25/106 – Correspondence**

- a) Non-Resident –Football pitch enquiry, girls 5x5 and 7x7, ages under 8 & 11
  - a. Atalanta FC would like to use the recreation ground to host football matches starting with the 2026/27 season after a recent visit with the Parish Clerk & Chair
  - b. Parking was discussed with a proposal to use the Parish Hall car park, only managers would use the recreation ground
  - c. Mainly Saturday mornings with the occasional Sunday morning usage
  - d. All Councillors present approved to support the project
  - e. Councillor Needham assigned to the project due to previous experience
  - f. Clerk to contact both Bishop's Waltham and Swanmore to get more information on set up and running costs
  - g. Councillor Cutler advised that grants for this could be available, and Councillor Chamberlain advised he could assist with the business application

**25/107 - Parish Council Finance**

- a) To endorse payments made for August 2025 (approved)
- b) To receive current financial statement of accounts to end August (approved)
- c) Confirm renewal of Zurich insurance at £900.72 per annum (based on a 3 year term)
- d) Confirm purchase of four picnic benches at a cost of £2240.40
